Medicines that sit in home cabinets are highly susceptible to diversion, misuse and abuse. Many do not know how to properly dispose of unused medicines, often flushing them down the toilet or throwing them away: both are potential safety and environmental hazards. The Signal Hill Police Department will work directly with the DEA to properly dispose of medication.

WILL COLLECT



- Controlled, non-controlled and over the counter substances.
- May bring medicine in original container or remove from its container and dispose directly into disposal box at site.
- All solid dosage pharmaceutical products and liquids in consumer containers
- Liquid products should remain sealed in their original container

WILL NOT COLLECT



- Intravenous solutions, injectables, syringes or medical waste
- Illicit substances such as marijuana or methamphetamines
