CALL TO ORDER

Chair Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chair Wilson led the audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

There was no public business from the floor.

PUBLIC WORKSHOP

- a. PRELIMINARY REVIEW OF AN 83' TALL WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS
FACILITY WITH ENHANCED TREATMENT TO RESEMBLE A PALM TREE AT
1320 E. HILL STREET

Acting Community Development Director Doan read the form of notice and provided an introduction for the workshop process. Assistant Planner Agbayani gave the staff report.

Commissioner Bell inquired whether the potential loss of two non-functional parking spaces identified on the plans would render the parking non-compliant.

Staff verified that a loss of two spaces would still leave the required twenty-one spaces required. Staff reiterated that the applicant will need to confirm the quantity, dimensions, and functionality of designated parking spaces prior to a public hearing.

Dayna Aguirre, authorized agent on behalf of the property owner, introduced herself and yielded to questions.

Vice Chair Richárd asked the applicant if they anticipated any difficulties in complying with the parking and paving requirements.

The applicant confirmed that they did not foresee any difficulties in meeting the requirements.

Commissioner Benson inquired about the number and frequency of Verizon employees on site, which was verified to be minimal.

There being no further testimony, Chair Wilson closed the public workshop.

The Commission instructed the applicant to work with staff to address the outstanding items prior to proceeding to a public hearing, which include:

- Verify the number of functional parking spaces with the correct stall and back-up dimensions;
- Include a note for all designated parking areas to be paved and striped;
- Remove all storage items obstructing required parking; and
- Designate outdoor storage areas that do not impact parking.

Chair Wilson called for a voice vote to continue the project to a future public hearing.

The motion carried 4/0.

The applicant, Joe Bergin introduced himself and thanked the Commission for consideration of his requested use and Mr. William "Toliver" Norris who manages the building where Mr. Bergin currently operates a UPS business services center praised him as a tenant and business operator.
