Council members cannot specifically discuss applications or public hearing items before the Planning Commission, since the City Council serves as the appeals board to commission actions.

- a. Ordinance Amending Signal Hill Municipal Code Sections 2.08.070D – Approval And Adoption of Ordinances and Resolutions for Payments of Money, and 2.08.040B – Time Of Meetings

Summary: Ordinance Nos. 2011-07-1427 and 2011-07-1428 were introduced at the City Council meeting of July 19, 2011, and are now presented for second reading and adoption.

Recommendation: Waive further reading and adopt the ordinances amending Signal Hill Municipal Code Section 2.08.070D allowing for the approval of payment of monies at regular meetings and special meetings for which the notice of such special meeting specifies the business to be transacted in accordance with California Government Code Section 36935, and amending Signal Hill Municipal Code Section 2.08.040B allowing for the notice of special

meetings of the City Council, Redevelopment Agency, Housing Authority, or Public Financing Authority be made to the legislative body and media via telephone or other electronic application.

(9) PUBLIC HEARING(S)

a. Public Hearing - Resolution Finding the City to be in Conformance with the Congestion Management Program

Summary: The Los Angeles County Congestion Management Program (CMP) requires that each city must self-certify its conformance to the CMP, annually, at a noticed public hearing. The resolution states that the City of Signal Hill is in conformance with all CMP requirements for the 2010-11 program year.

Recommendation: Waive further reading and adopt the resolution finding the City to be in conformance with the Congestion Management Program (CMP) and adopting the CMP Local Development Report, in accordance with California Government Code Section 65089.

(10) CITY MANAGER REPORTS

a. Contract Service Agreement for the Management of the Day Laborer Center

Summary: The City of Signal Hill has relied upon the services of a non-profit organization to manage the day-to-day operations of the day laborer center located in the Home Depot parking lot at 2450 Cherry Avenue. The non-profit organization, because of their financial issues, can no longer manage the day laborer center. This report discusses entering into a contract service agreement with an independent contractor who managed the center for the non-profit organization.

Recommendation: Authorize the City Manager to enter into a one-year contract agreement with the independent contractor to manage the day-to-day operations of the center.

b. Resolution Authorizing Submittal of a Grant for Restroom Replacement at Reservoir Park

Summary: Staff is requesting authorization to submit a grant application in the amount of \$150,000 to replace the restrooms at Reservoir Park.

Recommendation: Waive further reading and adopt the resolution approving the application for grant funds from the County of Los Angeles Regional Park and Open Space District Grant Program.
