There is a period for public comment on closed session matters at 6:00 pm prior to the closed session. In the event there is no business to be conducted in closed session, the regular meeting shall begin at 7:00 pm. There is a public comment period at the beginning of the regular meeting. Any person wishing to comment shall be allotted three minutes per distinct item. Any meeting may be adjourned to a time and place stated in the order of adjournment.

- a. CONTRACT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH STUDIO SPECTRUM, INC. FOR CITY COUNCIL CHAMBER AUDIO VISUAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Summary:

The City Council will consider entering into a new Contract Services Agreement with Studio Spectrum, Inc. (Studio Spectrum) to purchase and install new video hardware and broadcast systems, City Council Chamber and control room equipment, and provide streaming video services, including closed captioning, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$198,088.79, in a form approved by the City Attorney; and authorize the City Manager to approve a contingency in the amount not to exceed 10%.

Recommendation:

Authorize the City Manager to enter into a three-year Agreement with Studio Spectrum to purchase and install new video hardware and broadcast systems, City Council Chamber and control room equipment, and provide streaming video services, including closed captioning, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$198,088.79, in a form approved by the City Attorney; and authorize the City Manager to approve a contingency in the amount not to exceed 10%.

- b. OVERVIEW OF THE SIGNAL HILL LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Summary:

The City Manager's office developed the Signal Hill Leadership Academy (SHLA) to provide community members with an opportunity to gain in-depth insight into the workings of local government. This new community engagement initiative consists of a four-week leadership program aimed at providing community members with a comprehensive understanding of City government and encouraging active civic engagement. Through this academy, the City strives to make City functions more transparent and accessible to our Signal Hill residents and community members. SHLA will run for four weeks, commencing on Thursday, September 28, 2023, and concluding with a graduation ceremony at the City Council meeting of Tuesday, October 24, 2023.

Recommendation:

- a. RESOLUTION DECLARING FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF THE SPRING STREET BICYCLE LANE GAP CLOSURE PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 90.18003) PURSUANT TO THE PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT WITH SEQUEL CONTRACTORS, INC.

Summary:

Sequel Contractors, Inc. (SCI) completed the work for the Spring Street Bicycle Lane Gap Closure Project ("Project"), to the satisfaction of the Public Works Department and in accordance with the project plans and specifications. The Project was funded by a federal Active Transportation Plan Grant and included various improvements to the public right-of-way on Spring Street between Atlantic Avenue and Junipero Avenue including pavement rehabilitation, addition of new Class II bicycle lanes, street lighting, and other improvements. The final cost of the construction contract with SCI was \$1,899,150.49. Staff is recommending final acceptance of the work performed by SCI and issuance of final payment.

Recommendations:

1. Adopt a resolution, entitled:

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIGNAL HILL, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING WORK TO BE COMPLETED IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE SPRING STREET BICYCLE LANE GAP CLOSURE PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 90.18003) IN THE CITY OF SIGNAL HILL, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CONTRACT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN SEQUEL CONTRACTORS, INC. AND THE CITY OF SIGNAL HILL.

2. Authorize the Finance Department to release retention withheld from SCI on the project. The City may release the retention amount, totaling \$94,958, 30 days from the date the adopted resolution is recorded with the Los Angeles County, or 90 days after the last day of work on the project, whichever date occurs sooner.
- b. AMENDMENT TO THE RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMIT FOR HERITAGE POINT PARK

Summary:

The City Council will consider authorizing the City Manager to execute the First Amendment to the Right-of-Entry Permit between the City of Signal Hill and the City of Long Beach related to a property generally located on the west side of

Cherry Avenue and south of East Burnett Street. The property is owned by the City of Long Beach and is being used as part of Heritage Point Park.

Recommendation:

Authorize the City Manager to execute the First Amendment to the Right-of-Entry Permit between the City of Signal Hill and the City of Long Beach, for a term of one year, in a form approved by the City Attorney.

c. CONTRACT AMENDMENT REGISTER DATED AUGUST 8, 2023

Summary:

The Contract Amendment Register is a listing of proposed contract amendments and project change orders eligible for streamlined processing based upon the following criteria as documented in the City's Purchasing Policy:

- Funds have been authorized as part of the adopted fiscal year Operating Budget.
- Staff are satisfied with the goods/services received to date; and
- City Manager reviewed and approved each amendment for streamlined processing.

The contract amendments being presented for City Council consideration are as follows:

Desi Alvarez dba MCM Management Co.: Project management services for Well 10 Construction project (95.18011). Amendment No. 3 extends the term by four months through November 30, 2023, and increases compensation by \$16,000. The revised total not-to exceed contract amount is \$441,000.

Project Partners, Inc.: Professional water utility consulting support services for the Water Superintendent. Amendment No. 2 increases compensation by \$101,600. The revised total not-to-exceed amount is \$201,600.

AKM Consulting Engineers: On-call water engineering services for Temple Reservoir. Amendment No. 4 extends the term by one year through July 11, 2024.

Recommendation:

Authorize the Contract Amendment Register dated August 8, 2023.

d. FEE WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE FRIENDS OF SIGNAL HILL LIBRARY BOOK SALE

Summary:

The Friends of Signal Hill Library (FOSHL) is proposing to host a book sale fundraiser event on Thursday, October 12, 2023. FOSHL is requesting a waiver

of fees for the use of Signal Hill Library Community Room, City staff costs, and supplies for the set up and breakdown of their book sale. Additionally, FOSHL is requesting permission to promote their event by hanging banners on the Signal Point Terrace and at Hill Street and Temple Avenue.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that City Council review and approve a waiver of fees for use of Signal Hill Library Community Room, City staff costs, supplies, and allow FOSHL to display their banners for book sale promotion.

e. FEE AND ALCOHOL PROHIBITION WAIVER REQUEST FOR THE SIGNAL HILL COMMUNITY FOUNDATION ANNUAL FUNDRAISING EVENT

Summary:

The Signal Hill Community Foundation (SHCF) is proposing to host its annual fall fundraiser event on Friday, October 13, 2023. SHCF is requesting a waiver of fees for the use of the Signal Point Terrace, including staff fees, and a waiver of the alcohol prohibition on City property and live music policy. The SHCF secured an off-site, private venue as its primary space for this event, and would like to secure the City venue as an alternate.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that City Council approve the request for the waiver of fees for use of the Signal Point Terrace, City staff costs, and supplies; and waive the policy to allow live music and alcohol on City property for this annual fundraising event.
