

**A REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY OF SIGNAL HILL
PLANNING COMMISSION
June 16, 2020
7:00 P.M.**

A Regular Meeting of the Signal Hill Planning Commission was held via video/teleconference on June 16, 2020, pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20 issued by Governor Gavin Newsom.

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Wilson called the meeting to order at 7:03 p.m.

Chair Wilson announced tonight's meeting will be conducted virtually and asked the Community Development Director to provide meeting participation directions.

Chair Wilson led the audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC BUSINESS FROM THE FLOOR

There was no public business from the floor.

REORGANIZATION

a. Reorganization of Chair and Vice Chair

Commission Secretary Doan called for nominations for Chair.

Commissioner Parker nominated Vice Chair Richárd to be the Chair of the Planning Commission.

PUBLIC HEARING

- a. CUP 19-02 for Construction of an 83' Tall Wireless Communications Facility Monopalm at 1320 E. Hill Street

Community Development Director Doan read the form of notice and Assistant Planner Agbayani gave the staff report.

There were no questions or comments from the Commission to staff.

Chair Richárd opened the public hearing.

The applicant-agent, Dayna Aguirre, introduced herself and yielded her time to questions.

Vice Chair Bell asked about the anticipated maintenance schedule for the monopalm.

Ms. Aguirre replied that routine maintenance occurs every 4-6 weeks and usually involves a standard-sized passenger truck. Maintenance usually takes about 1-2 hours per session and occurs during regular business hours (not during sensitive time frames).

There being no further public testimony, Chair Richárd closed the public hearing.

It was moved by Commissioner Wilson and seconded by Vice Chair Bell to waive further reading and adopt the following resolution:
