a. Preliminary Review of A Target Retail Center and New Self-Storage Facility

Form of Notice: Notice was published in the Signal Tribune newspaper per Government Code §65091(a)(4) on March 5, 2021; notice was posted in accordance with Signal Hill Municipal Code Section 1.08.010 at City Hall, Signal Hill Library, Reservoir Park, and Discovery Well Park on March 5, 2021; and notice was mailed to affected property owners and occupants within a 300' radius on March 5, 2021.

Summary: The Planning Commission will conduct a workshop to provide the community with an opportunity to comment on the proposed Gateway North Commercial Center before scheduling a public hearing. The project is a 13.63 acre site located on the south side of E. 33rd Street between Atlantic and California Avenues in the North End neighborhood. The project is intended to be built in phases and includes:

- Renovation of the existing Target store (interior and exterior);
- Construction of a new three-story, 177,345 square-foot self-storage facility;
- Construction of a new commercial space totaling 18,500 square feet (to be built as tenants are secured);
- Construction of a new 5,000 square-foot drive-thru restaurant (to be built as a tenant is secured).

Topics to be discussed at the workshop include:

- Establishment of a Specific Plan to guide the development of the center and list permitted uses, in recognition of a series of development constraints which are unique to the site;
- Review of the conceptual site plan for the phased build-out of the center;
- Review of the customized traffic and parking studies for the project;
- Review of the exterior renovation of Target, including new wall signs;
- Review of the new self-storage facility including wall signs; and
Review of proposed monument and freeway signs for the commercial center.

Recommendations:

- 1) Open the public workshop and receive testimony;
- 2) Provide direction as deemed appropriate for:
 - The proposed Specific Plan;
 - The conceptual site plan for the commercial center;
 - Site Plan and Design Review for the exterior remodel of Target;
 - Site Plan and Design Review for the proposed self-storage facility;
 - Customized traffic and parking studies; and
 - Signs.
- 3) Direct the applicant to continue to work with staff to complete any outstanding items, and to return for future public hearings with the Commission and Council.
