MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING SIGNAL HILL PLANNING COMMISSION November 15, 2022

FINAL

A Regular Meeting of the Signal Hill City Council was held in-person and via video/teleconference on November 15, 2022 pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 54953 (as amended by AB 361).

Chair Parker called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

(3) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chair Parker led the audience in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.
