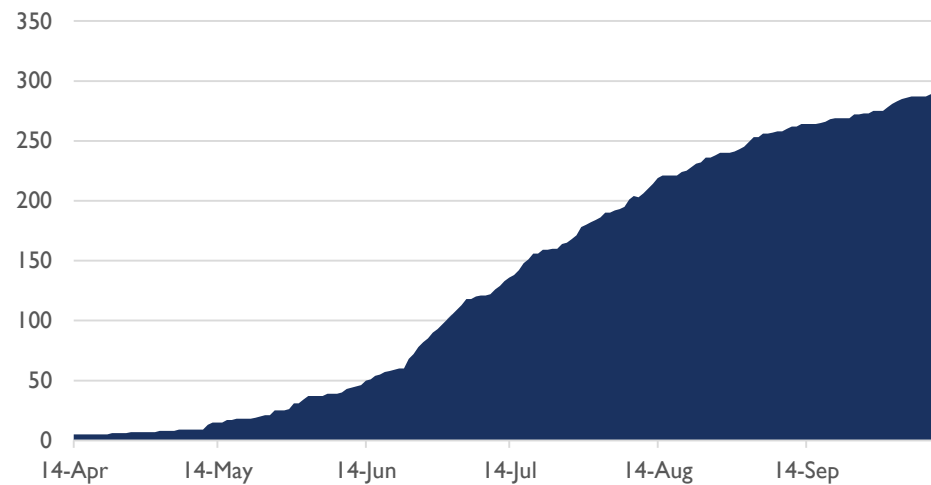

CITY PLAYGROUNDS

- Everyone 2 years+ should wear a face covering
- Stay home if you are sick
- No eating or drinking is allowed at the playground
- Wash or sanitize hands before and after your visit
- Visits should be limited to 30 minutes when others are in the playground
- Adults or caregivers are required to ensure children maintain at least 6 feet of distance from others that are not part of their household
- Elderly individuals and those with underlying medical conditions should avoid playgrounds when others are present

OTHER REOPENINGS

- Breweries and wineries
 - Open for outdoor dining operations
 - Must produce their own beer and/or wine
 - Alcohol must be purchased in the same transaction as a meal
- Nail salons at 25% occupancy
- Indoor retail establishments and shopping malls at 25% occupancy

LA COUNTY COVID-19 SAFETY COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

- LA County is offering a free online training course “COVID-19 Safety Compliance Certification Program”
 - Focuses on the implementation of safety protocols
 - Business owners receive a certificate and window seal to display
 - Reassures employees and customers that the business is following public health requirements

LA COUNTY CARES ACT FUNDING – CHILD CARE



- Child care for essential and low-income workers now through December 30, 2020
- Eligible families must be:
 - Essential workers or low-income working families (health care industry, emergency services, food and agriculture, etc.)
 - Must live in Los Angeles County
 - Must need child care to go to work
 - Is not able to work remotely
 - Meet certain income eligibility
 - In a two-parent household, both parents must either be essential workers or unable to provide care due to incapacitation

LA REGIONAL COVID FUND

- Grants, loans, and coaching and technical assistance to support micro-entrepreneurs, small businesses, and non profits
- Round 6: October 26 – October 30
 - Grant winners are chosen through a randomized application system, but applications who meet certain criteria will be weighted more heavily in the system in order to support the most vulnerable community members
 - Veteran-owned small businesses
 - Areas with higher unemployment rates, lower education rates, lower median household incomes, and lower jobs-to-population rates

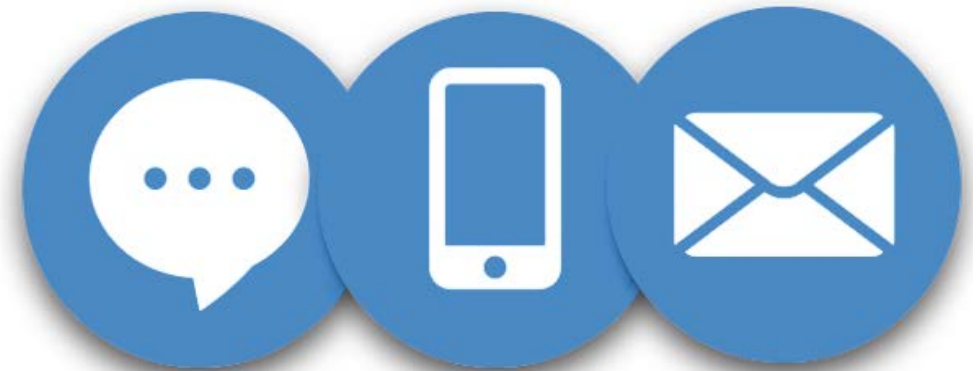
