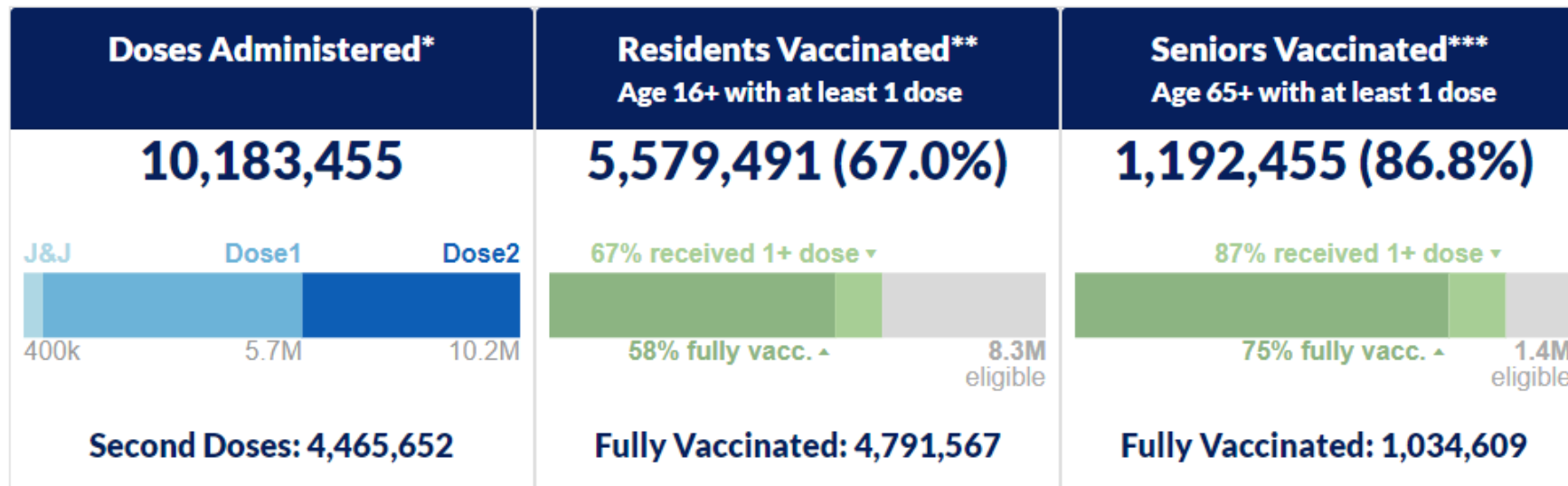

COVID-19 VACCINATIONS IN LA COUNTY

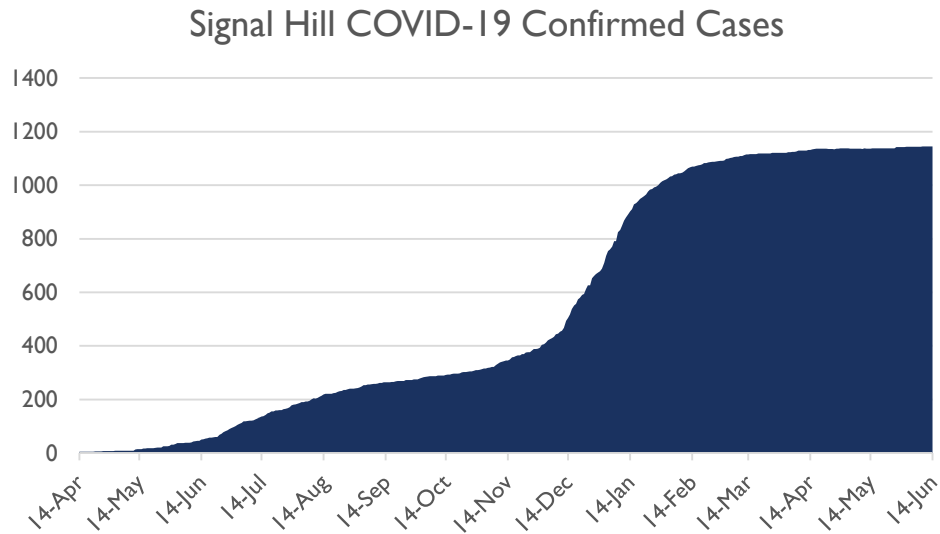

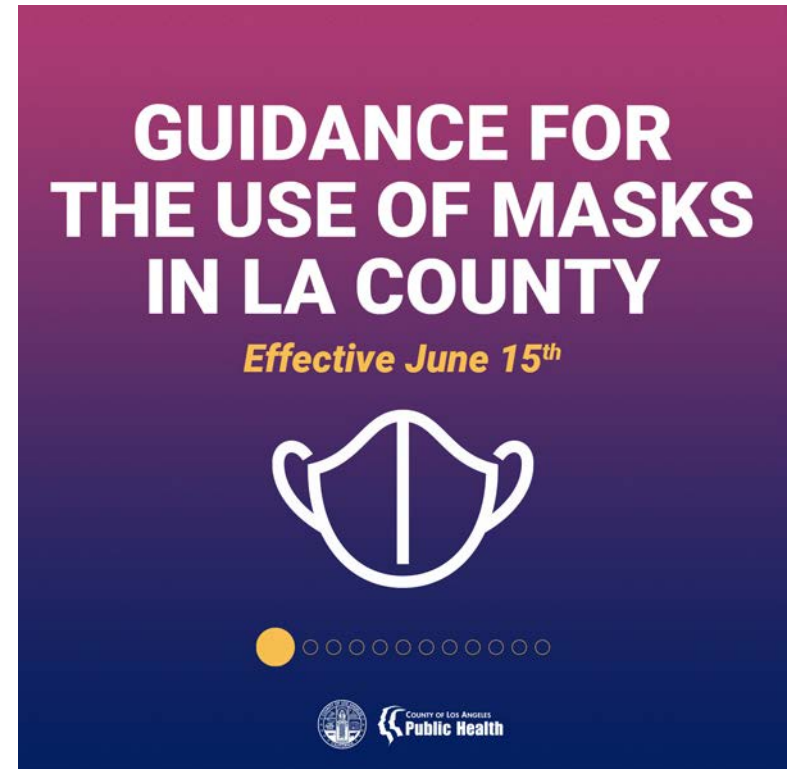

MASKING GUIDELINES PART I

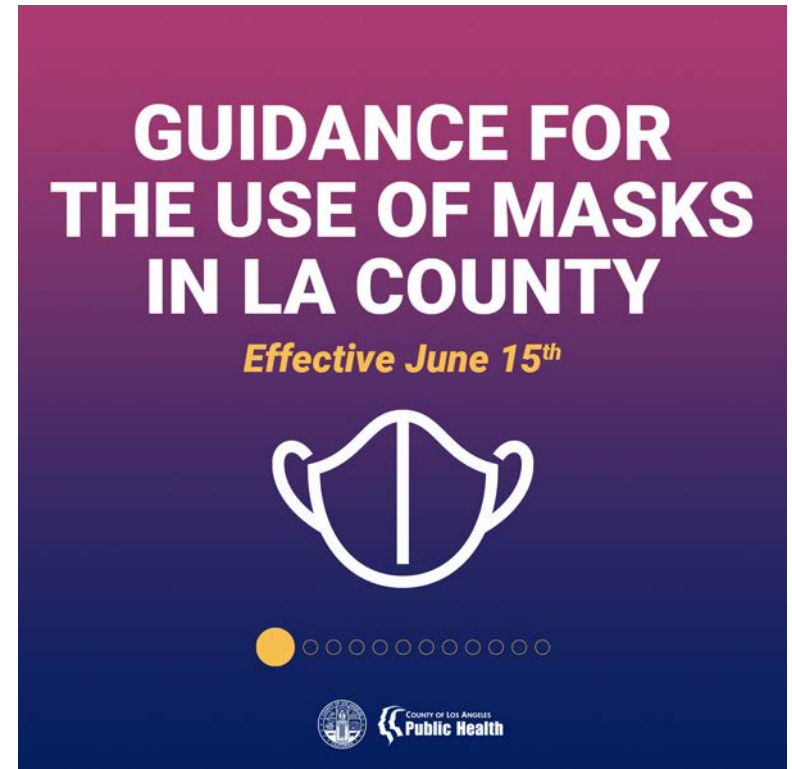
- Masks will not be required for fully vaccinated people, except in the following settings where masks are required for everyone, regardless of vaccination status:
 - Public transit and in transportation hubs;
 - Indoors in K-12 schools, childcare and other youth settings;
 - Healthcare settings, including long term care facilities;
 - State and local correction facilities and detention centers; and
 - Homeless shelters, emergency shelters, and cooling centers.

MASKING GUIDELINES PART II

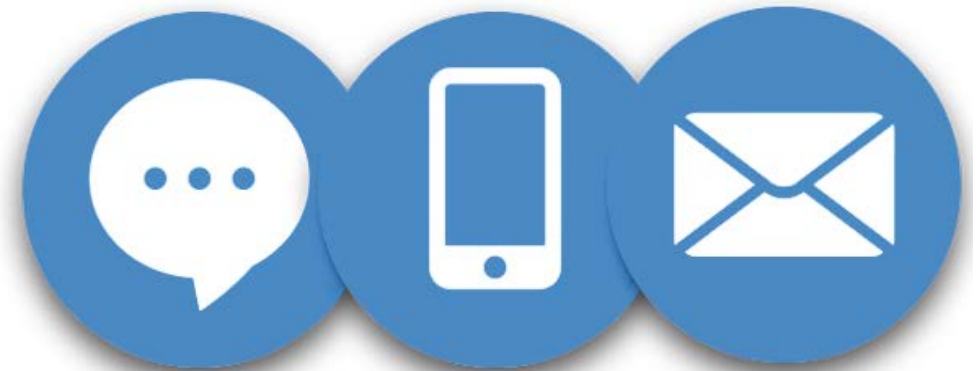
- Masks will be required for unvaccinated people in indoor public settings and businesses. This includes:
