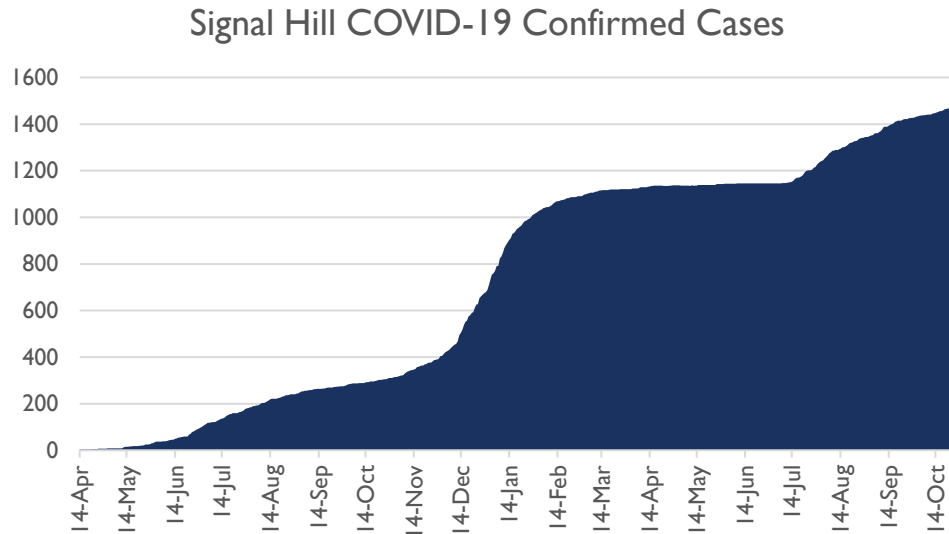

- 65 years and older
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who work or live in high-risk settings

Received a J&J dose at least 2 months ago & are 18+

**⚠️ CDC recommends these steps to reduce your risk of getting and spreading COVID-19:**

- **Get a COVID-19 vaccine** as soon as you can when eligible. Individuals 12 years old and over are currently eligible. Continue to follow the steps below every day until you are fully vaccinated.\*
- **Wear** a mask over your nose and mouth.\*
- **Stay** at least 6 feet away from people who don't live with you.\*
- **Avoid** crowded areas and poorly ventilated spaces.\*
- **Wash** your hands often with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.

\*Fully vaccinated people can participate in many of the activities that they did before the pandemic. People are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's vaccine. To maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading to others, wear a mask indoors in public if you are in an area of substantial or high transmission.

**CDC** **Watch for COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, cough, or difficulty breathing for 14 days following an exposure.**

If you develop any symptoms, get tested for SARS-CoV-2, and stay home and away from others until:

- it has been 10 days from when your symptoms first appeared and
- you have had no fever for 24 hours without the use of medications and
- your other symptoms of COVID-19 are improving\*

(\*Loss of taste and smell may persist for weeks or months after recovery and need not delay the end of isolation)

**Based on the answers given, you should get tested 3-5 days after exposure and wear a mask in public indoor settings.** To maximize protection from the Delta variant and prevent possibly spreading to others, wear a mask indoors in public if you are in an area of substantial or high transmission.

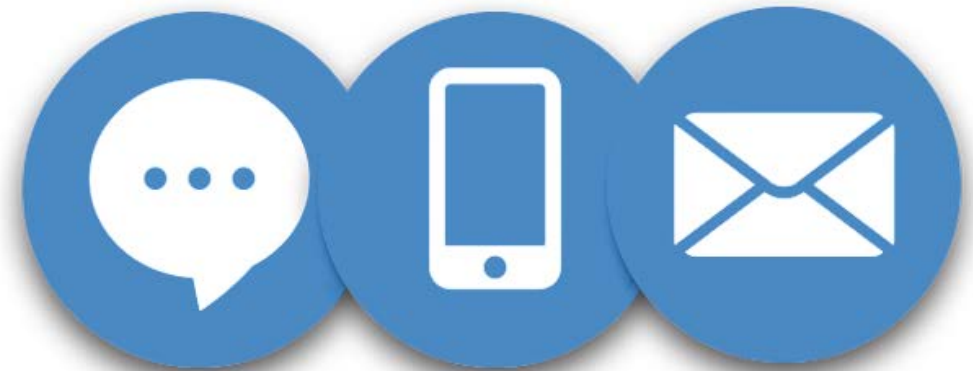
