IMPACTS TO CITY SERVICES DUE TO COVID-19 SURGE

Current community transmission of COVID-19 in L.A. County is extremely high. Please get a COVID-19 vaccine and booster dose if you are able, wear a well-fitting and high-quality mask when leaving home, keep your distance from others when possible, and frequently wash your hands. The City of Signal Hill is under the jurisdiction of the [L.A. County Department of Public Health](#) (LACDPH) and must follow all County, State and Federal orders.

The City of Signal Hill is issuing the following updates and temporary modifications to City service operations, effective immediately:

- The Signal Hill Public Library is temporarily pausing all in-person events and programs that require close contact and in-person gathering. The Library will remain open for regular business hours. All patrons must wear a mask (over the age of two) and stay distanced from other patrons not in their household when inside the Library. Patrons are encouraged to utilize the Library's collection of [digital resources](#), including the Library catalog, downloads, e-books, and more, available 24/7.
- Impacted programs and events include the following:
 - Active Adults in-person indoor events, including Senior Social Club
 - All Story Time programs
 - Homework Help, in-person computer assistance and all one-on-one services that require close contact
 - Teen programs, including Library Drop-In and Homework Help
 - January monthly events including First Friday Book Club, Anime at the Library, and Classic Films at the Library

Impact on City Services
