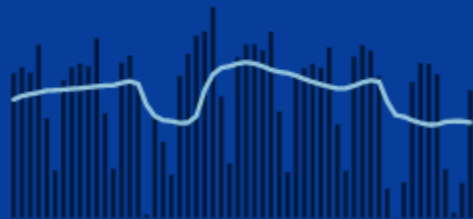

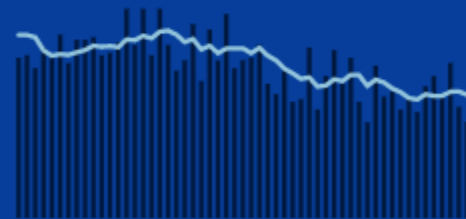

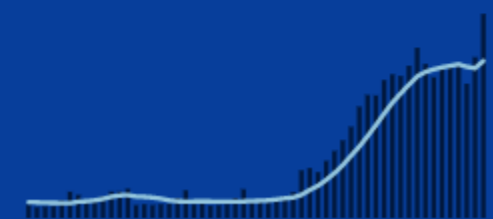

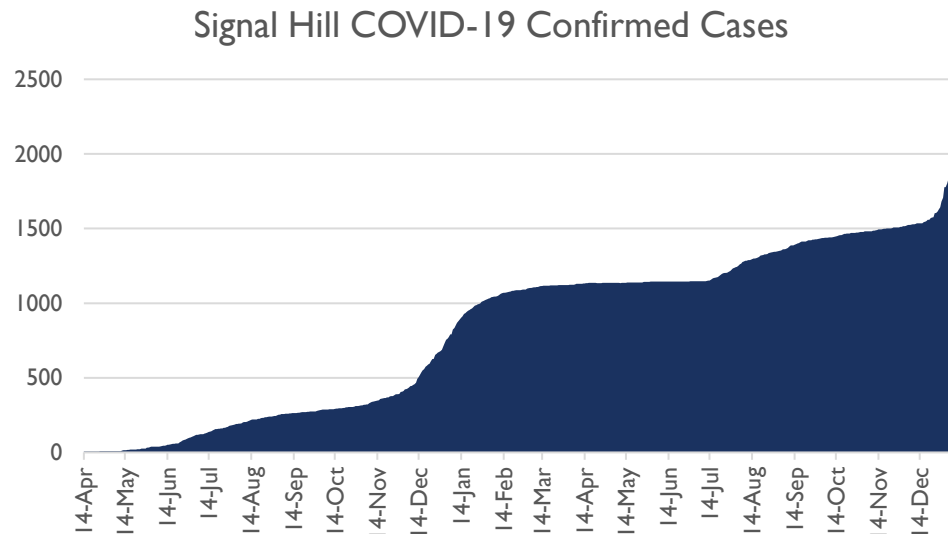

# LACDPH HEALTH OFFICER ORDER (JANUARY 5 & JANUARY 10, 2022)

- Beginning January 15, 2022, attendance thresholds are lowered to 500 attendees for Indoor Mega Events and 5,000 attendees for Outdoor Mega Events.
- No later than January 17, 2022, employers are required to provide their employees, who work indoors and in close contact with other workers or the public, with and require them to wear a well-fitting medical grade mask, surgical mask, or higher-level respirator, such as an N95 or KN95, at all times while indoors at the worksite.

# FAQS

- When should I get tested?

Get tested, even if you are fully vaccinated and/or boosted, when:

- You have symptoms;
- You are a close contact to someone with Covid-19;
- If you have traveled internationally or to areas in the US where Covid is spreading rapidly; and
- As an extra layer of protection to protect others, such as before and after attending a gathering or event.

# FAQS

- What if I test positive?
  - All persons who test positive, regardless of vaccination status, previous infection, or lack of symptoms, must self-isolate for at least 5 days.
  - Persons may end their self-isolation after Day 5 if
    - They are asymptomatic or are fever free and their symptoms are improving; or
    - They take a viral test collected on Day 5 or later and test negative.
  - If they are unable to test or choose not to test, and symptoms are not present or are resolving, isolation can end after Day 10.
  - Wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days, including around household members.
  - Tell all your close contacts that they have been exposed.

# FAQS

- What if I am notified as a close contact?
  - Quarantine immediately.
  - Get tested immediately.
  - If your test is negative, test again on Day 5 after the exposure.
  - Monitor your health and wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days, including around household members.

# FAQS

- How do I quarantine as a close contact?
  - All unvaccinated persons or fully vaccinated persons who are eligible for a booster but have not yet received their booster dose, who are close contacts of a Covid-19 case, must quarantine for at least 5 days after their last contact with a person who has Covid-19.
  - They must test on Day 5 after their last exposure.
  - Quarantine can end after Day 5 if they are asymptomatic AND they take a viral test on Day 5 or later and test negative. If they are unable to test or choose not to test, and symptoms are not present, quarantine can end after Day 10.
  - Monitor your health and wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days, including around household members.

- Who does not need to quarantine (general public)?
  - Individuals who have received their vaccine booster OR are fully vaccinated and are not yet eligible for a booster or have recovered from Covid-19 within the previous 90 days, do not need to quarantine following an exposure.
  - Monitor your health and wear a mask around others for a total of 10 days, including around household members.
  - If symptoms occur, individuals must immediately isolate and test as soon as possible.

# FAQS

- Who does not need to quarantine (workplace)?
  - Individuals who have received their vaccine booster OR are fully vaccinated and are not yet eligible for a booster or have recovered from Covid-19 within the previous 90 days, do not need to quarantine following an exposure.
  - In a workplace setting (not applicable to healthcare personnel), asymptomatic employees may continue to work on the condition that:
    - They get a viral test within 3-5 days after their last exposure to a case;
    - They wear a well-fitting medical grade mask around others for a total of 10 days;
    - They remain asymptomatic; and
    - They observe home quarantine when not at work.
  - If symptoms occur, individuals should immediately isolate and test as soon as possible.

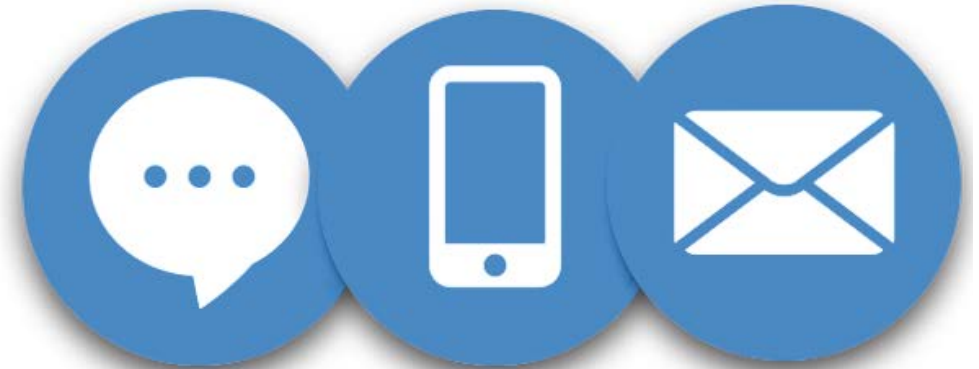
