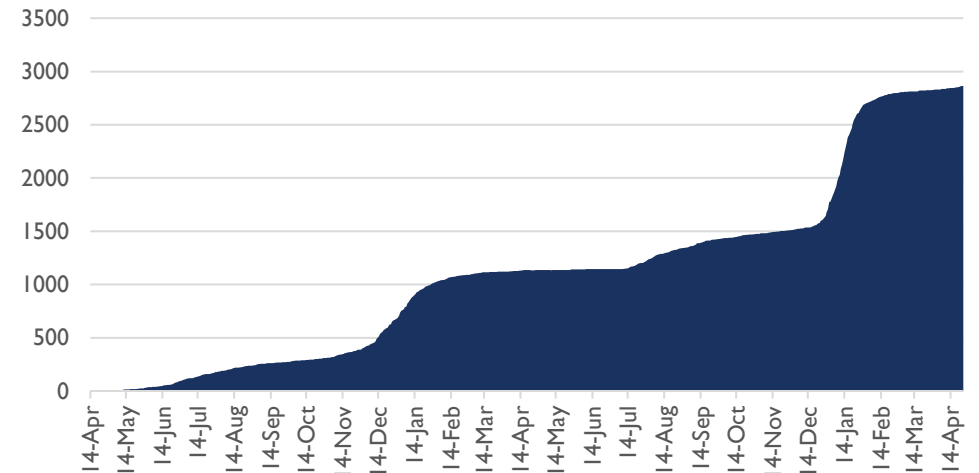

SIGNAL HILL

- Signal Hill: 2,863 (+27) confirmed cases, 13 (+0) deaths
- Health Officer Order (April 21)
 - LA County is currently experiencing increases in cases and test positivity rates, and hospitalizations are no longer in decline.
 - The COVID-19 burden on the County's health care system is currently at a Low level.
 - Community transmission continues to be at a Substantial level based on CDC indicators.
 - The BA.2 subvariant is now the predominant subvariant, and the first two cases of a new subvariant, XE, have been identified in California, but not LA County.

LACDPH UPDATES

- Quarantine Updates for Close Contacts
 - Close Contact: Shared the same indoor airspace for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period
 - You are not required to quarantine, regardless of your vaccination status, if you have no symptoms OR if you have no symptoms and previously tested positive using a viral test for COVID-19 in the past 90 days and recovered.
 - Must wear a highly protective mask for a total of 10 days after the last contact with COVID-19
 - Test within 3-5 days after your last exposure. If you test positive, follow isolation requirements.
 - Monitor yourself for symptoms and test again if symptoms develop.

LACDPH UPDATES

- Masking in Public Transit
 - Masking continues to be required in all public transit within the County per CDC's continuing assessment.
 - Requirement will be reassessed when
 - Community transmission drops to the moderate level, or
 - CDC assessment changes, or
 - Within 30 days of the April 21, 2022 order.

- When You Need to Wear a Mask in LA County
 - All public transportation, including trains, buses, taxis and ride-shares.
 - All indoor transportation hubs, including airport and bus terminals, train and subway stations, seaports and indoor port terminals.
 - In healthcare settings
 - In long-term care settings and adult/senior care facilities
 - Shelters and cooling centers
 - Correctional facilities and detention centers
 - Any location where it is the policy of the business or venue

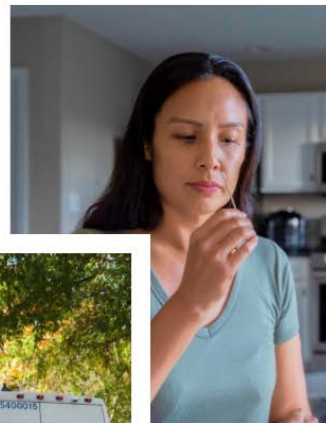

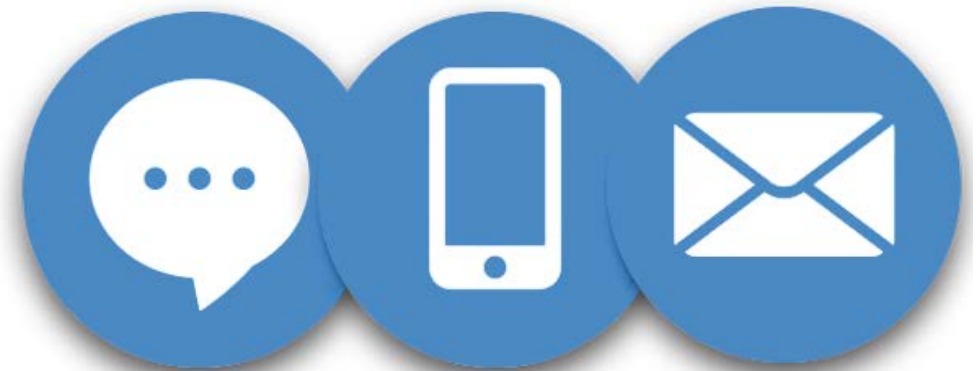
