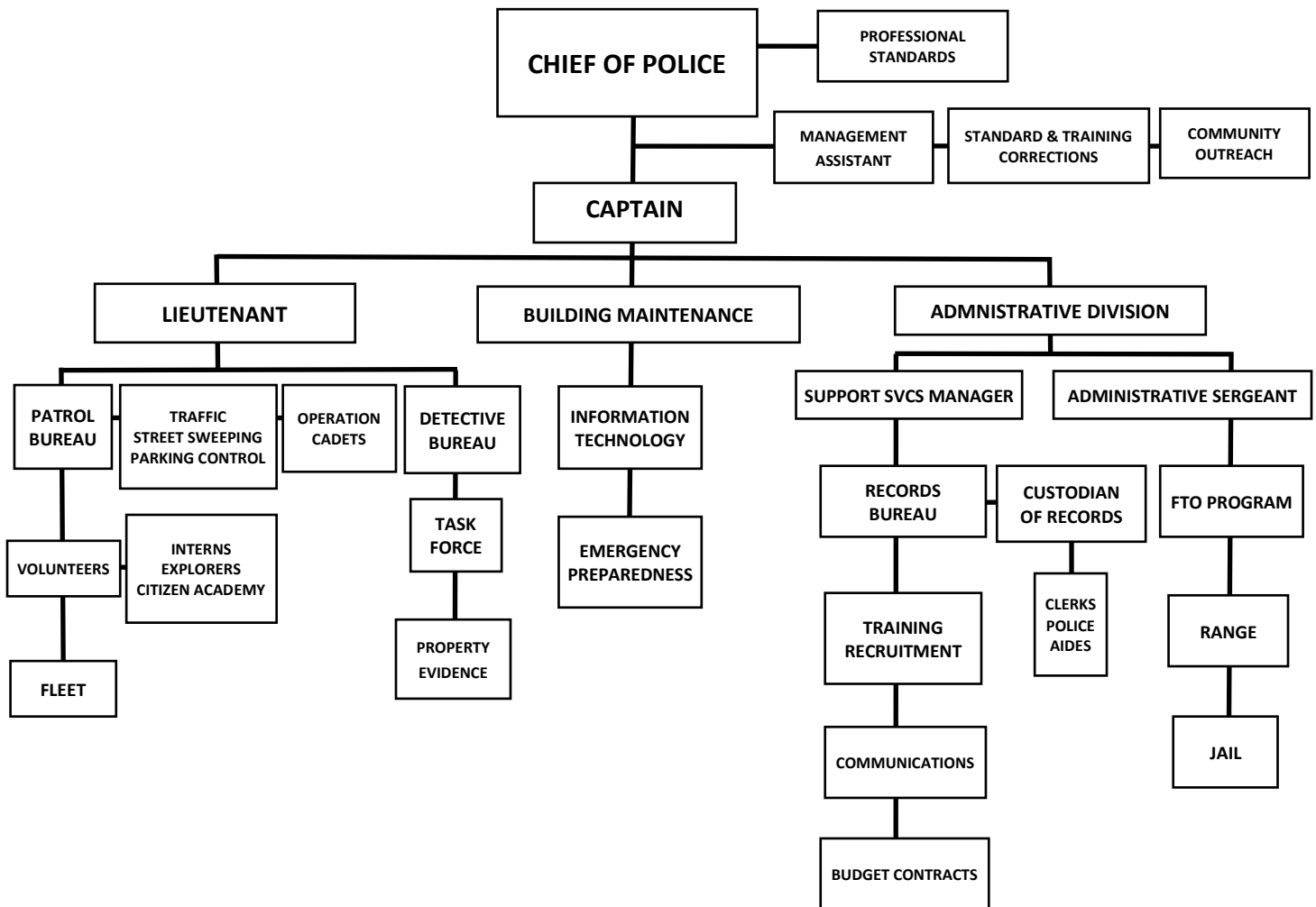

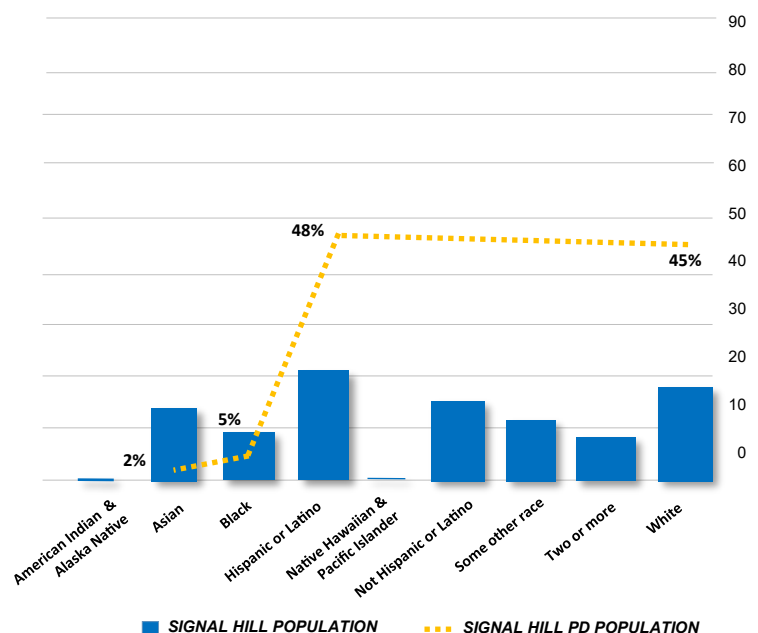

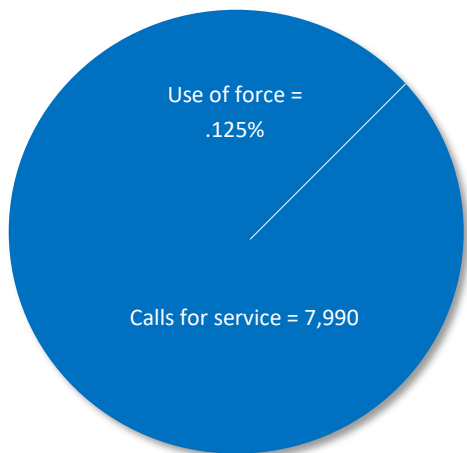

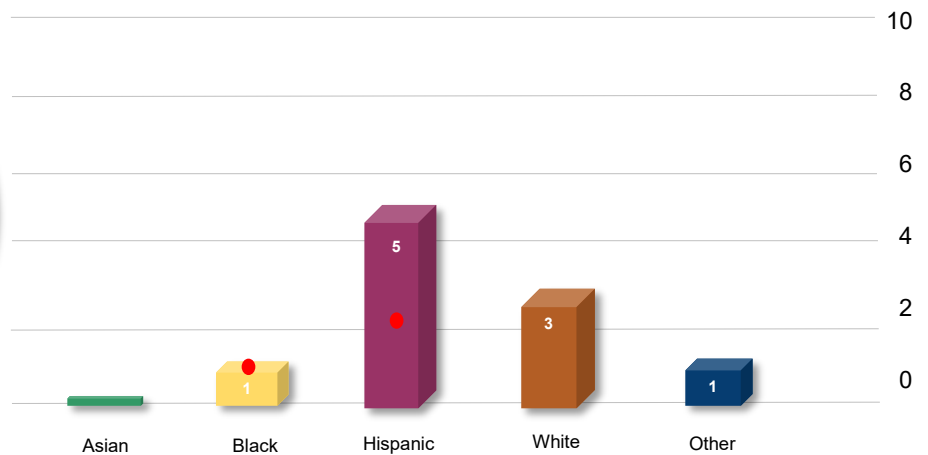

2022 Use of Force by Race



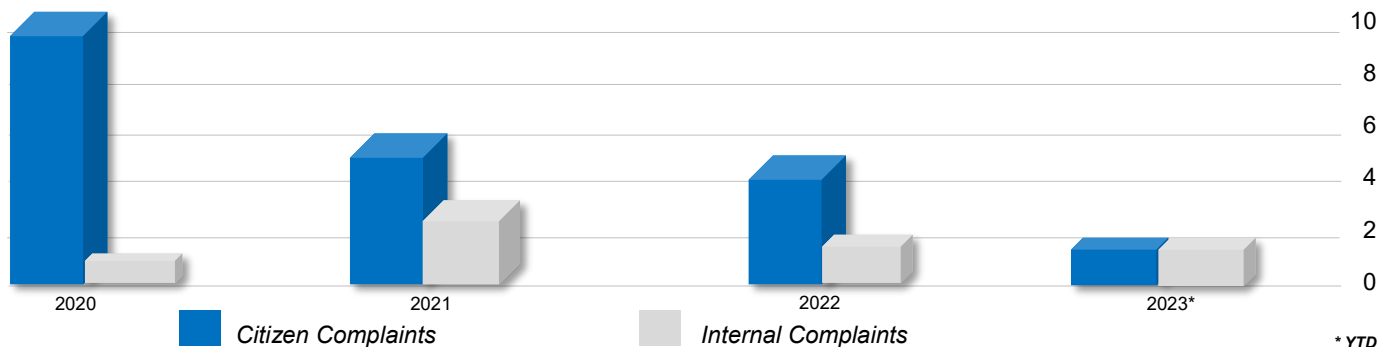

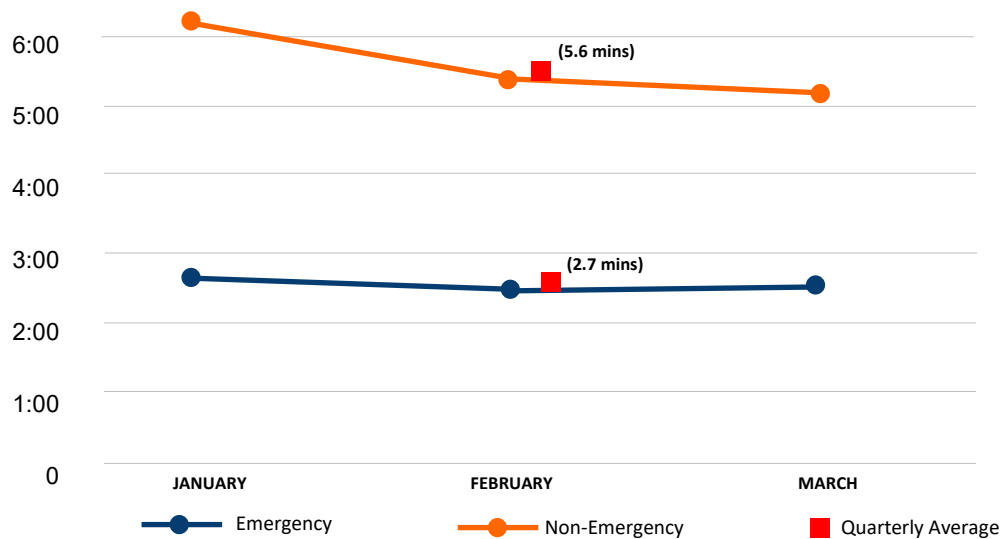

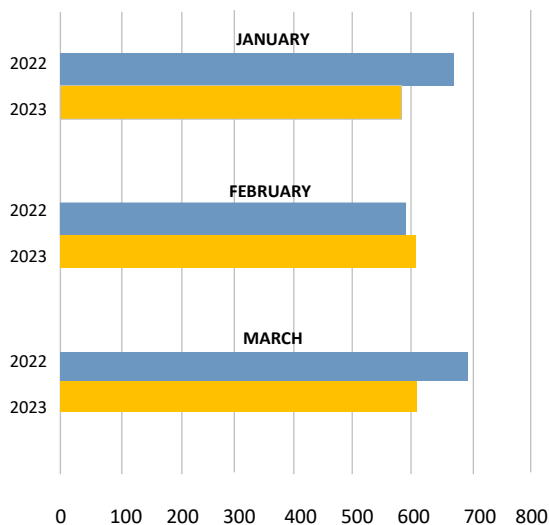

Average Response Time

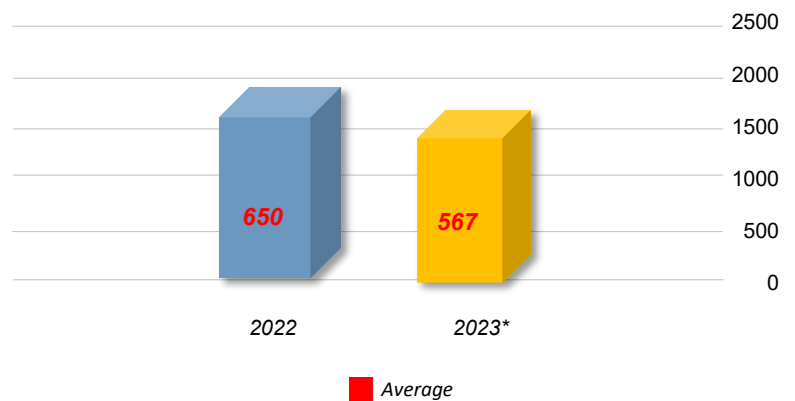

2022-2023 1st Quarter Average Comparison

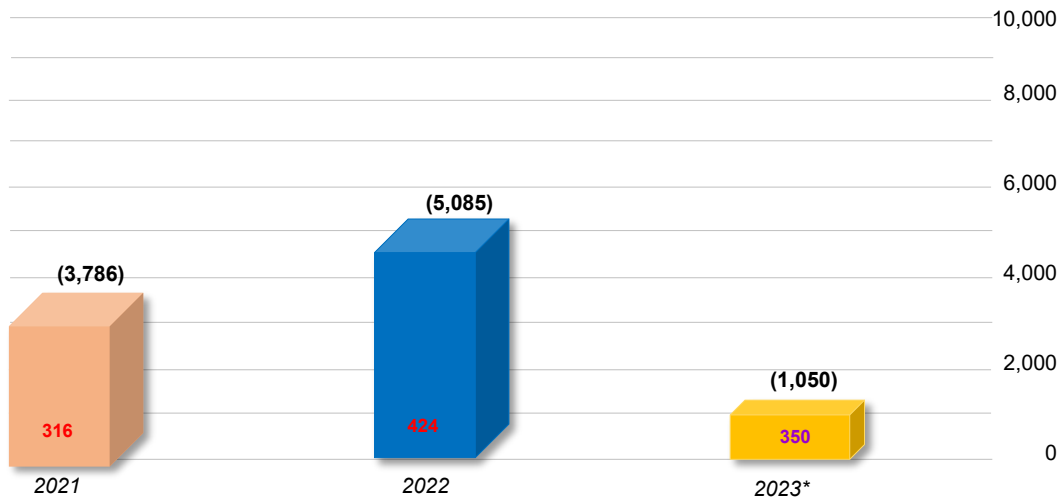

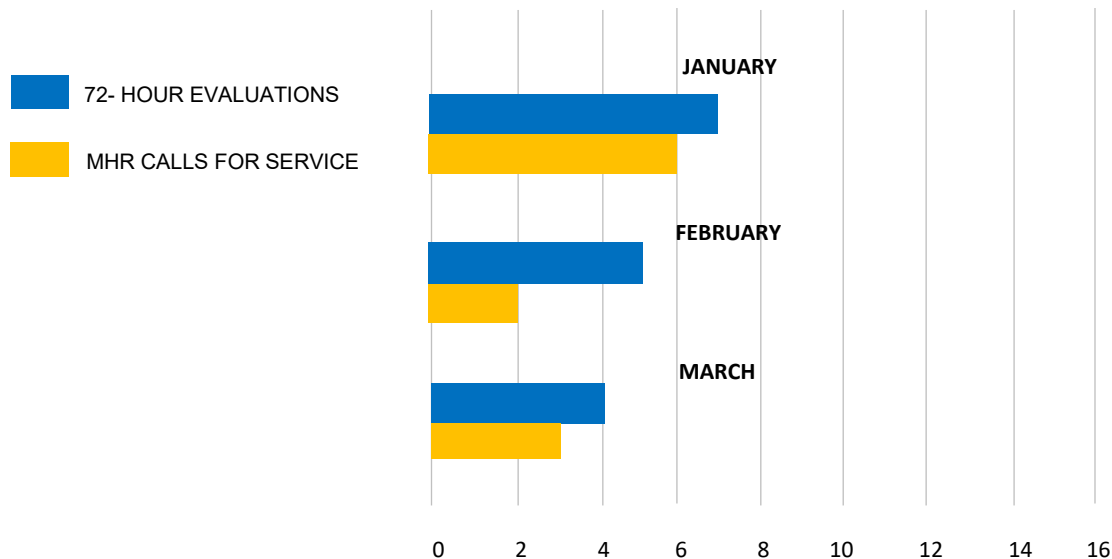

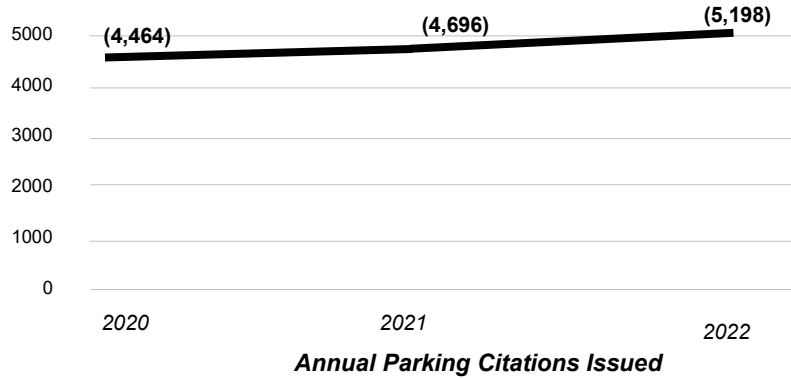

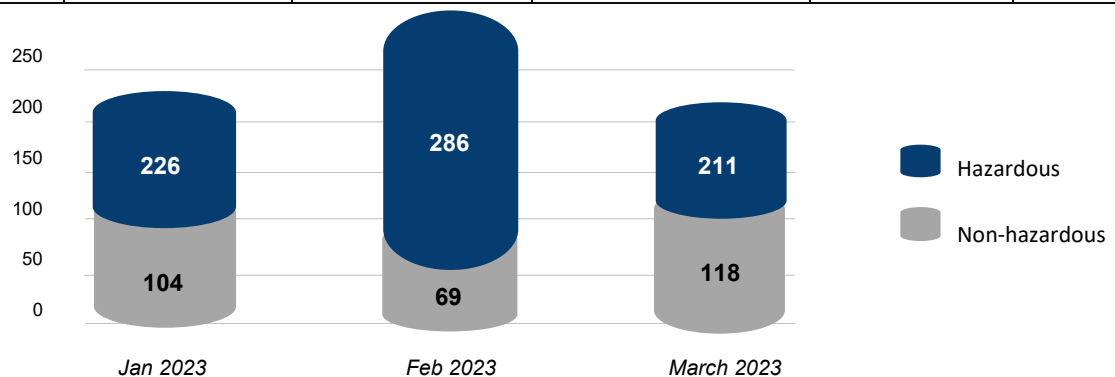
PARKING CITATIONS

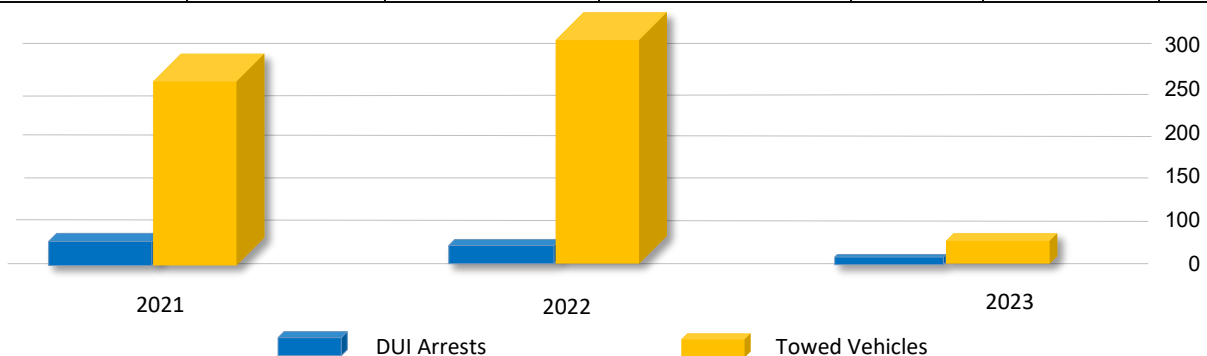

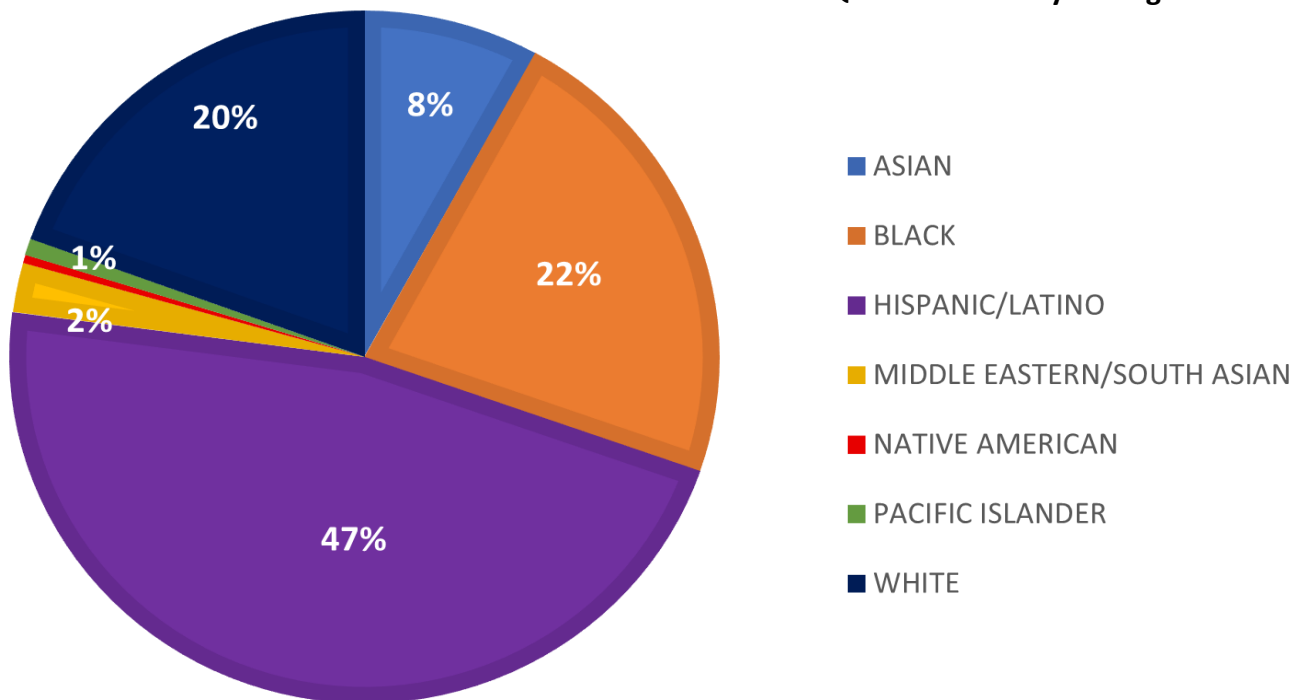

RACIAL IDENTIFICATION and PROFILING ACT (RIPA)

In accordance with California Assembly Bill 953, the Signal Hill Police Department began collecting data regarding subject detentions. The Department of Justice (DOJ) required agencies to collect data as of January 2022. Among other things, data collected includes the perceived race or ethnicity, gender and approximate age of person detained, reason (s) for detention, whether or not a search was conducted and the result (s) of the detention.

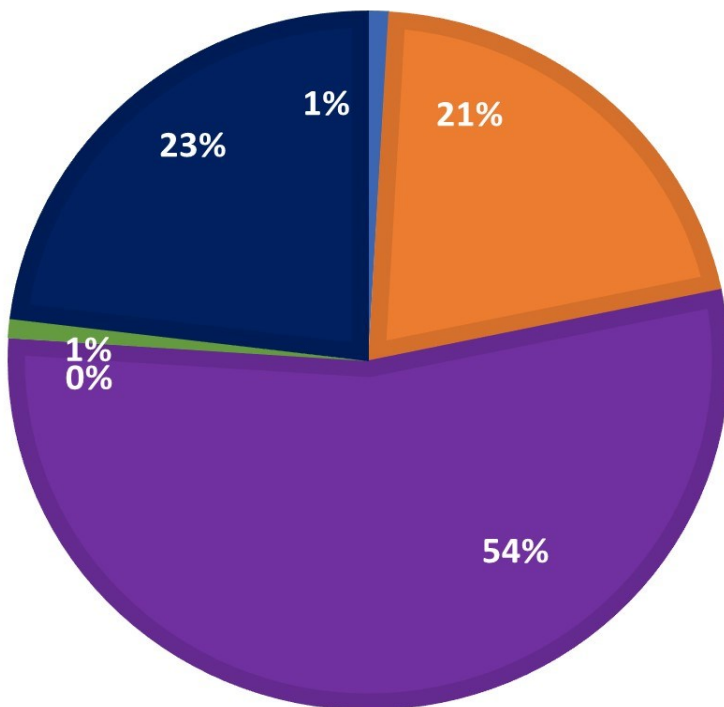
