Captain Kenneally began his law enforcement career with the Orange County Sheriff’s Department, where he served for 28 years. Over the course of his distinguished tenure, he has held the ranks of Sergeant, Lieutenant, and Captain. His exemplary service was recognized in 2010 when he received the department’s prestigious Deputy of the Year award.

One of the highlights of his time with the Orange County Sheriff’s Department was his leadership at the Central Justice Center in Santa Ana—Orange County’s largest and busiest court. As the commanding officer, Captain Kenneally oversaw daily court operations and supervised more than 120 sworn and non-sworn personnel. His ability to manage complex systems and large teams laid the foundation for the strategic leadership he brings to Signal Hill today.

In 2024, Captain Kenneally joined the Signal Hill Police Department, quickly immersing himself in all aspects of department operations.
